


Key findings




It's who you meet: why employer contacts at school make a difference to the employment prospects of young adults -

- Shows a significant link between young people's experience of the world of work whilst at school and the chances of them becoming NEET
- 26.1% of young people who could recall no contact with employers whilst at school went on to become NEET
- This reduced significantly to **4.3%** for those who had taken part in four or more activities involving employers

- 95% of young people would like employers to be more involved in providing advice and guidance about careers and jobs
- 42% of young people had no contact with employers at all
- Young people who had been in contact with 4 or more employers were nearly twice as likely to believe that they had a good idea of the knowledge and skills needed for the jobs they wanted to do


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- Inspiring the Future is a FREE service run by the charity the Education & Employers Taskforce

Careers guidance and inspiration for young people in schools - statutory

Evidence from the Education and Employers Taskforce shows that access to a network of employers is associated with better outcomes for young people. Employers can pass on the benefits of their experience to both pupils and teachers, helping to link curriculum subjects to employment and providing an overview of the different routes into careers.

Inspiring the Future – A free service across England with volunteers from all sectors and professions going into state secondary schools and colleges to talk about their jobs and sectors.








- We have signed up over 20,000 volunteers from 5,000 different organisations and our growth is steadily rising







Adding Volunteers to an existing Project/Event or creating a new one

After you have clicked


In this section you can either add volunteers to an existing project/event or create a new project. If this is your first time of using Inspiring the Future or you are an existing user using the new improved pages for the first time, you will need to select the tab 'Create New Project' tab below, then create a 'Project Name' and click




Adding Volunteers to an existing Project/Event

If you have used the new improved Inspiring the Future pages and either created a Project/Event that you would like to add more volunteers too, or a Project that you would like to use but create a new Event in that series with a different date. Simply, click select Existing Project select the **Project** you have already created, then select **Event** and either select an existing event to add volunteers to or click and by adding a new date in the volunteer invite, you will subsequently create a new event that sits under the project name you have selected.







You will now be taken to the volunteer invite page where you can construct your invitation. Your school/college details will automatically be added. You simply need to add:


- Activity Date
- Total Hours
- Number of Students
- Year group/s covered

Then:

- Subject Title of Invite
- Message
- Any supporting web links

Add Activity Date


To add an activity date, click in the activity date box and a calendar will appear.

Select the date you would like to hold your event by selecting the day or using the left and right cursor bars to move through the months.

When you're happy with the selected date, click:




Add Total Hours & Number of Students

In the '*Total Hours'* box, add the number of hours the activity will last for. Remember, volunteers have committed to an hour.

In the 'Number of Students' box, add the approximate number of students you think will be attending the event





Add Year Group Covering Ages


In the 'Year Group Covering Ages' section, pick the year group/s that the volunteer will engage with.

Simply click in the box under the title and a year group selection box will appear:



Pick the appropriate year group. If you would like to add more than one year group simply click in the box and repeat the process





Add Subject Title, Message and optional URL links

In the 'Subject Title' give the event a title that will appeal to the volunteer such as 'Careers Fair – 31st January 2015'

Then enter the 'body of the message', giving the volunteer as much information as you can about the event and what you expect of them within the 1,000 character limit/

Optional – If you need to, you can add an URL link and title with further information.


When you're happy with your invite message to your selected volunteers, click:

After you press send on the invite to volunteers, you will automatically be taken to your 'My Projects/Events' section. In this area you can see the Project/Event you have created, and you have the ability to Edit the event details or invite more volunteers if needed.
